## Children & Families First Benefits from Mattress Firm's Foster Care Donation Program

(Wilmington, DE) - Children & Families First (CFF) announced that they've been selected to help launch Mattress Firm's Foster Kids Program in Delaware. Foster children in CFF's care will receive clothing, school supplies, shoes, and toys as beneficiaries of Mattress Firm's Foster Kids Program.

Mattress Firm's board of directors voted unanimously to select Children & Families First to help launch the Mattress Firm Foster Kids program in Delaware. This partnership will help to provide basic essentials to Delaware foster youth and also to bring awareness to the many youth who are in care. CFF Development Director, Elizabeth Dougherty, is delighted by this new partnership; "It's an honor for Children & Families First to be selected by Mattress Firm for this great program, but it's so much more than that. This is a reminder to our children in foster care that, regardless of their circumstances, people, even strangers, care about their well-being and want to help."

Throughout the year, the Mattress Firm Foster Kids program holds donation drives at select stores to collect essential items such as pajamas, clothing, shoes, holiday gifts and school supplies for foster children in need. Each drive collects several thousand essential items for foster youth. There is an additional Dollar Drive that raises thousands of dollars to be used toward the purchase of additional items and to provide extracurricular activities and lifeshaping childhood experiences. After each drive, donations are distributed to our carefully chosen non-profit foster care partners.

Since 1919, CFF has partnered with over 3000 resource families and facilitated 2,518 adoptions. In 2015, 972 Delaware youth were in foster care with an average of 653 youth in care every month. That number is expected to grow as an estimated 600 Delaware babies will be born addicted, many requiring separation from their parents.

Mattress Firm is embracing the needs of the 400,000 children throughout the country who are in foster care. These children often suffer the effects of poverty, neglect, and abuse. That's why Mattress Firm is joining forces with local non-profit organizations and local communities in an

effort to help these children beat the odds. Together with the community, Mattress Firm wants to provide children with the little things that often make a big difference: school supplies, shoes, clothing, and holiday gifts.
